Where you can find information about the Town

Municipal information can be found in the Bulletin Board pages in the Thursday edition of a local newspaper called *The Liberal*, which is delivered to every household free of charge Thursdays and Sundays. If you are not receiving your copy, call (905) 881-3373 to arrange for delivery. Throughout the year, the Town produces and distributes a number of useful printed publications. The Community Services Leisure Guides are full of programs and activities for people of all ages. Since it also lists community centres and sports, arts and social groups, you may want to keep it on hand. The Guide will be delivered to your home three times a year and is also available for pick up at community centres, libraries and at the Town's Municipal Offices. It can be viewed on the Town's Website, too. There is also an information rack in the main Municipal Offices' lobby (accessible 24/7) with information about Town services. Much of this information can be picked up at any Richmond Hill community centre or library, as well.

Contacting your Councillor

Many Councillors have their own websites and newsletters that they use to provide information on issues of concern in their wards. The Mayor and all Members of Council can be reached by telephone or via email. If you are unsure of which ward you live in or which Councillor represents you, call the Office of the Clerk at (905) 771-8800 or check the ward maps on the Town's website. Information regarding Council meeting dates, agendas and minutes are available through the Office of the Clerk, as well as online.

Waste Management

The Town is proud of the strides it has made in the area of waste management and encourages you to recycle and compost whenever possible. If you are a new resident and in need of a Blue Box, you may pick one up for \$10 from Access Richmond Hill at the main Municipal Offices located at 225 East Beaver Creek Road and from the Operations Centre at 1200 Elgin Mills Road East, near Leslie Street. Green Bins and in-house bins are also available for \$18 and \$4, respectively. You must provide proof of residency. Each winter, the Town produces a schedule for waste (recycling and garbage) collection. You can pick one up at the Town's main Municipal Offices or by visiting the Town's website. Important By-laws

As a new resident, there are a number of by-laws you need to know about, including ones relating to pet ownership. The Town also has a Water Restriction By-law (No. 181-98) that comes into effect each summer. In addition, the Town's Parking By-law (No. 402-89) states that there is no overnight parking on Richmond Hill streets. Parking on a street between the hours of 3 and 6 a.m. is subject to a fine of \$30 upon conviction. Also, a new by-law has been passed restricting front yard parking to driveways only (No. 84-03), of which shall not exceed the stated dimensions and must be constructed of acceptable materials. Property owners that violate the regulations will be fined and may be required to revert their driveways back to the original configurations. Tax and Water Bills

Residential property tax bills are issued twice a year by mail. There are a number of ways to arrange payment of your property taxes. Payments can be made at most financial institutions, through bank machines, by telephone and Internet banking or through the Pre-authorized Payment Plan. Call (905) 771-8949 for details. Tax and water bill payments may be made during business hours at the main Municipal Offices and may be dropped off 24-hours a day in one of our drop boxes. There is a drop box in the Lobby of the main Municipal Offices and another at the Operations Centre. Purchasers of newly constructed homes are billed taxes for land only upon closing. Once the building is assessed, a supplementary bill is issued. The supplementary bill for the building portion of the assessment will be from the date of closing, which could be retroactive for up to two years. These taxes will be payable in two installments only; therefore, new owners are advised to plan in advance for the eventual payment of these taxes, as the due dates may overlap with the normal billing cycle.

There's lots to do in Richmond Hill

Richmond Hill has many attractions, too many, in fact, to list here! Some of the highlights include the Heritage Centre - a fully restored 1840s Regency style cottage where activities such as art gallery talks, craft workshops and educational historical programs are hosted; the Wave Pool features four-foot tall waves and a 160-foot long twisting water slide; and the McConaghy Seniors' Centre, which offers recreational activities and events for residents who are 60 years of age or older.

Other Services

Responsibility for public transit lies with the Regional Municipality of York. Information regarding transit, bus routes and schedules is available by contacting York Region Transit at (905) 762-2100 or by visiting www.yorkregiontransit.com. Services such as Police, EMS, Public Health, Social Assistance and Housing, as well as some roads and planning services, are provided by the Region of York.
